

## ENBRIDGE LINE 5 AMERICA'S MOST DANGEROUS PIPELINE

- Line 5 is a 645-mile pipeline sending Canadian oil to Canadian refineries via WI and MI, including through the Straits of Mackinac in the Great Lakes
- Line 5 is operating in defiance of Tribal treaties and a 2021 shutdown order
- igta Enbridge is already responsible for the largest inland oil spills in MI & MN
- Enbridge seeks to replace the original twin pipelines with a new one, to be placed within a tunnel being dug under the Straits of Mackinac
- We must STOP THE FAST-TRACKING of permits from the Army Corps of Engineers for this dangerous and costly tunnel project









## ENBRIDGE LINE 5 A THREAT TO THE GREAT LAKES

- The Great Lakes contain 21% of Earth's freshwater, used by 40+ million people
- 23 million gallons/day of petroleum flow through two 72-year-old pipes on the lakebed of the Straits of Mackinac in the Great Lakes
- The Straits of Mackinac are a busy shipping channel with strong currents between Lake Huron and Lake Michigan
- The pipes' protective coating is eroding and they have been struck twice in recent years, once by Enbridge itself
- Since 1968, Line 5 has spilled 33 times for a total of 1.1 million gallons
