

THREE KEY ILLINOIS CLIMATE BILLS

With environmental regulations and clean energy under attack, states must to do more to protect the environment and reduce the global warming that is causing increasing climate disasters. The Illinois Legislature has a chance to help fill this gap by passing strong environmental legislation in 2025.

SB0005/HB1833: The Metropolitan Mobility Authority Act will help ensure that Illinois offers cleaner, safer transportation options, which can save up to \$250 million a year by unifying transit agencies in Northeast Illinois and also improve air quality.

SB2473/HB3779: The Clean and Reliable Grid Act will strengthen our power grid, increase transmission and storage of clean energy, and deliver price stability for ratepayers.

SB2269/HB3525: The Clean and Healthy Buildings Act will protect our health and the environment by requiring all newly constructed buildings to comply with a pollution standard and by supporting alternative heating systems such as Thermal Energy Networks in transitioning away from polluting fossil fuels.
